


When did abstraction in art begin?

Why express yourself in the abstract?

Abstract expressionism

- -Responding to the alienations after WWII.
- -Not really a formal movement
- -Based in NYC
- -Convey emotion through abstraction




Action Painting (this is the standard orientation for this painting)








