

WHAT IS CONSENT AND APPROVAL?

When you and your contributors provide consent and approval on the FAFSA form, you agree to:

- Share your personally identifiable information provided on the form with the IRS
- Have your federal tax information transferred directly into the form
- allow the U.S. Department of Education (ED) to use the information to determine your eligibility for federal student aid,
- Allow ED to share your federal tax information with schools and state higher education agencies, and
- Allow ED to reuse federal tax information on other FAFSA forms you're invited to



WHAT DO CONTRIBUTORS NEED TO DO?

After listing the name, date of birth, Social Security Number (SSN), and email of your contributor they will be sent an invitation to complete their portion of the FAFSA application via the email you provided for them.

- Create a StudentAid.gov account if they don't already have one.
- Log into their account using their FSA ID account username and password.
- Once logged click on the invitation from the student's FAFSA application.
- Provide the required information on the FAFSA form, and consent to share their Tax Information from the IRS to the FAFSA form.
- Add their signature at the end of the application and submit.
