COMPLETE ALL YOUR FINANCIAL AID REQUIREMENTS

Submit your:

- FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid)
- TAP application
- For non-FAFSA filers apply for aid through the <u>Senator Jose Peralta</u> <u>DREAM Act</u>

Completing these applications is essential when it comes to your financial aid and ASAP scholarship.





MEET WITH YOUR ACADEMIC ADVISOR

Before registering for classes, make sure to meet with your advisor to discuss your academic goals and address any concerns. Remember, most financial aid awards are based on your academic progress and performance, so it's crucial to maintain good grades and complete your courses successfully.

CHECK YOUR CUNYFIRST TO-DO LIST

Be sure to regularly check your CUNYfirst To-Do List for any additional financial aid requirements. Failing to complete these tasks could impact your eligibility for aid.
