! Summer 2026 Fast Facts:

Enroll in **Summer 2026** to **catch up** or **get ahead!**

- There are 5 Summer Sessions beginning **May 28** or **July 20**.
- Summer classes are **fast-paced**. Be prepared to attend **all** classes and stay on top of assignment **deadlines**.
- If your plans change, **drop the course before it begins** to avoid charges (WN grades result in a bill).
- Check the **BMCC academic calendar** for key deadlines.
- Summer financial aid may be available based on your **eligibility, enrollment, and academic standing**.
- ASAP students who meet the requirements below qualify for the **Summer ASAP Tuition & Fee Award** and **book support**. The ASAP Award is applied after all other aid and covers any remaining tuition and fees.

★ **5-week classes**
July 20 – August 19

★ **6-week classes**
May 28 – July 15

★ **7-week classes**
May 28 – July 8

★ **10-week classes**
May 28 – Aug 5

★ **12-week classes**
May 28 – Aug 19

✓ ASAP Summer Checklist:

To receive **ASAP financial support for Summer 2026**, you **must**:

- Actively participate in ASAP.**
- Register for an approved Summer course by May 1st:**
 - The course must be **approved** by your ASAP Advisor **and** satisfy a major requirement according to DegreeWorks. (Dropping or **not** attending the course will **cancel** your funding.)
- Complete all financial aid requirements:**
 - Complete FAFSA and TAP for both **2025-2026** and **2026-2027**
 - If you're a non-FAFSA filer, apply for TAP through the NYS Dream Act.
 - Complete all financial aid tasks listed on your CUNYfirst To Do list

FAQs

Is summer aid available to me?

You may qualify for the ASAP Tuition & Fee Summer Award, Summer Pell Grant, or Summer TAP Award. Learn more about the different types of financial aid options: <https://openlab.bmcc.cuny.edu/asapfinancialaid/types-of-summer-aid/>.

Why is "Satisfactory Academic Progress" important?

You must meet annual Satisfactory Academic Progress standards to maintain eligibility for federal aid every year. Academic progress will be evaluated at the end of Spring 2026. If you fail to meet these standards, you will be required to submit a [Title IV Appeal](#). For more information: <https://www.bmcc.cuny.edu/federal-satisfactory-academic-progress-standard/>

How do I find out if I qualify for summer funding?

Your CUNYfirst Student Center provides information about your financial aid awards. After registering and completing all [financial aid requirements](#), your eligible awards will be applied to your CUNYfirst "Financial Aid" tile.

What options do I have if my advisor does not "approve" my summer enrollment?

If your advisor does not approve your summer course, you will **not** receive ASAP tuition or book funding. You may still qualify for a Summer Pell Grant—Complete the 2026-2027 FAFSA, review your awards on CUNYfirst, and contact the Office of Financial Aid if you have any questions.

What happens if I drop or withdraw from a summer course?

- Speak with your ASAP Academic Advisor **before** dropping or withdrawing—they will review how it affects your degree progress and graduation timeline.
- Drop **before** classes begin to avoid charges:
 - May 28 → drop by May 27
 - July 20 → drop by July 19
- Dropping/withdrawing may impact financial aid. Contact Financial Aid for details.

Will I receive financial aid for Study Abroad in the Summer?

If you meet Summer Aid requirements, you may receive tuition coverage. Study Abroad programs include additional costs (fees, travel, housing, airfare) which are **not** covered by ASAP. How do I access the ASAP Summer Book Assistance?

If eligible, you will receive your book funding by Direct Deposit or a Mailed Check.
