








Socialization





In Dogtooth, the parents are the primary agents of socialization, and they create an environment in which they control every aspect of their children's understanding of the world. Through their control over language, behavior, and the children's environment, the parents mold the children's identities in a very limited and distorted way.

The scene shows how the parents teach the children a reality based only on what they want them to believe, completely cutting them off from external sources of information.

The parents act as gatekeepers to knowledge, dictating what is real and what is not, which in turn socializes the children to a warped version of reality.

This scene highlights how agents of socialization, particularly the family in this case, can shape not just knowledge and behavior, but also worldview and self-concept. The children's entire sense of self and reality is built on the narrow and manipulated teachings of their parents, which is a stark commentary on the power that agents of socialization (especially family) have in shaping a person's life trajectory and beliefs.




For example, if students are caught violating campus policies (e.g., underage drinking, loud parties, curfew violations), security guards intervene, issuing warnings or fines.
