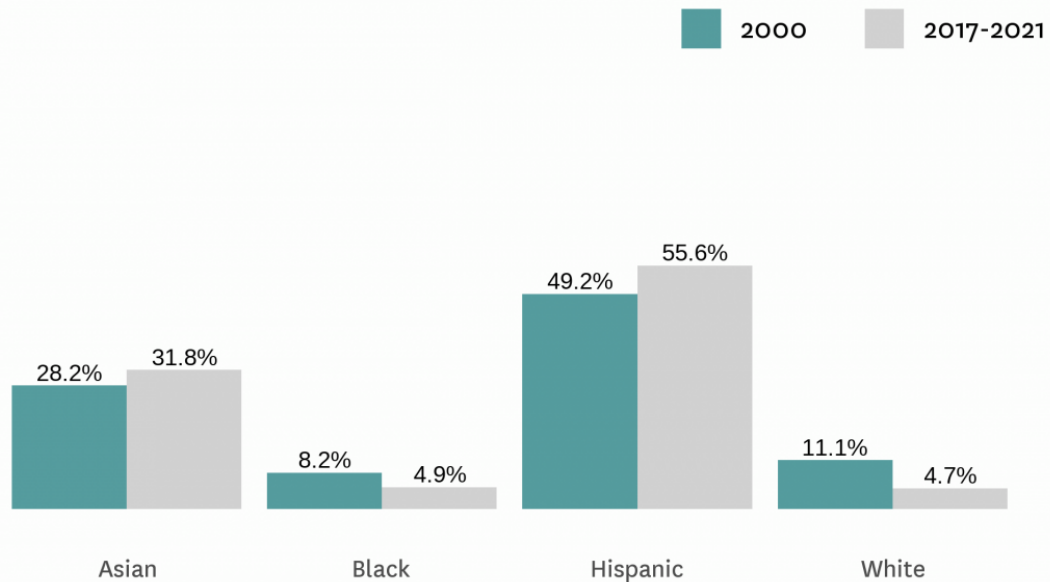

Racial and Ethnic Composition of Elmhurst/Corona



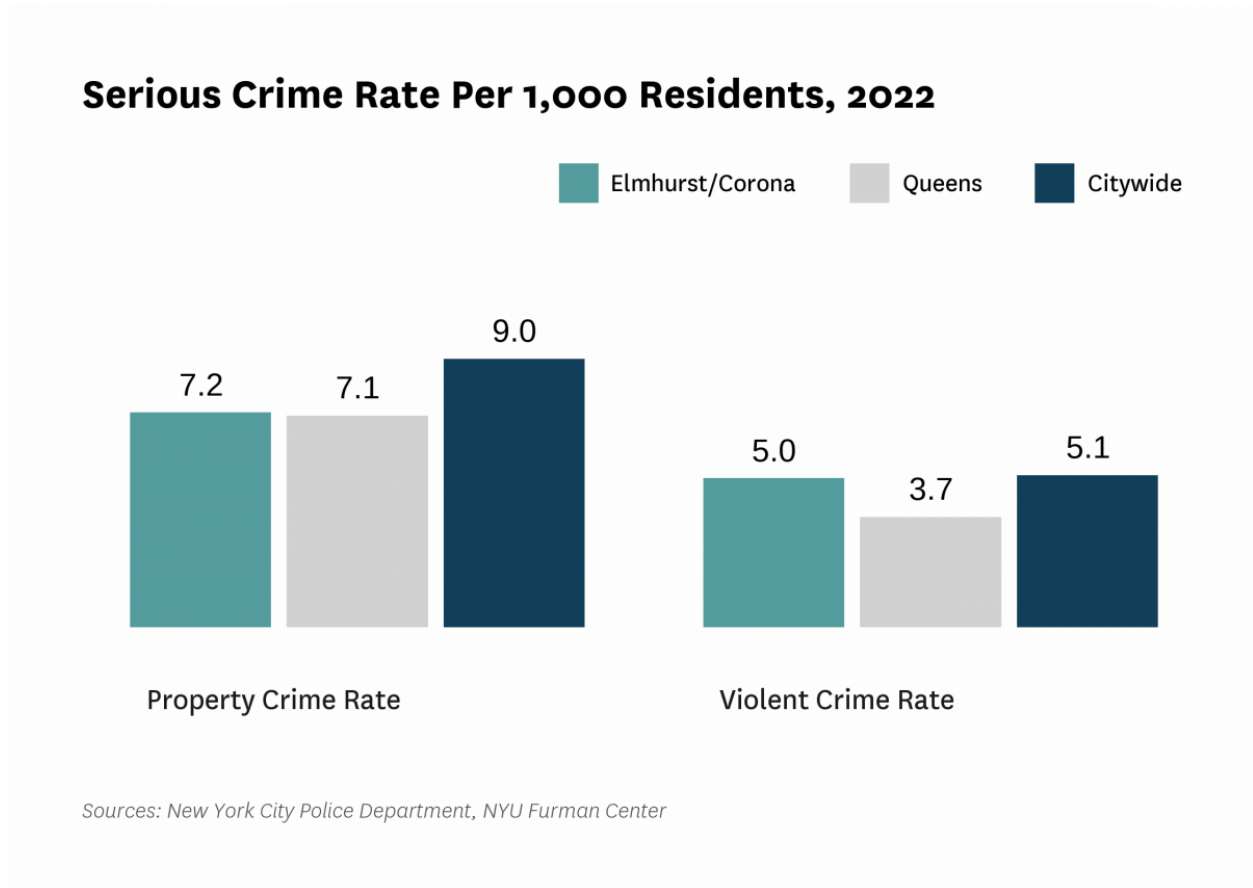

In 2021, there were an estimated 137,364 people in Elmhurst/Corona, of which 31.8% identified as Asian, 4.9% identified as Black, 55.6% identified as Hispanic, and 4.7% identified as white.

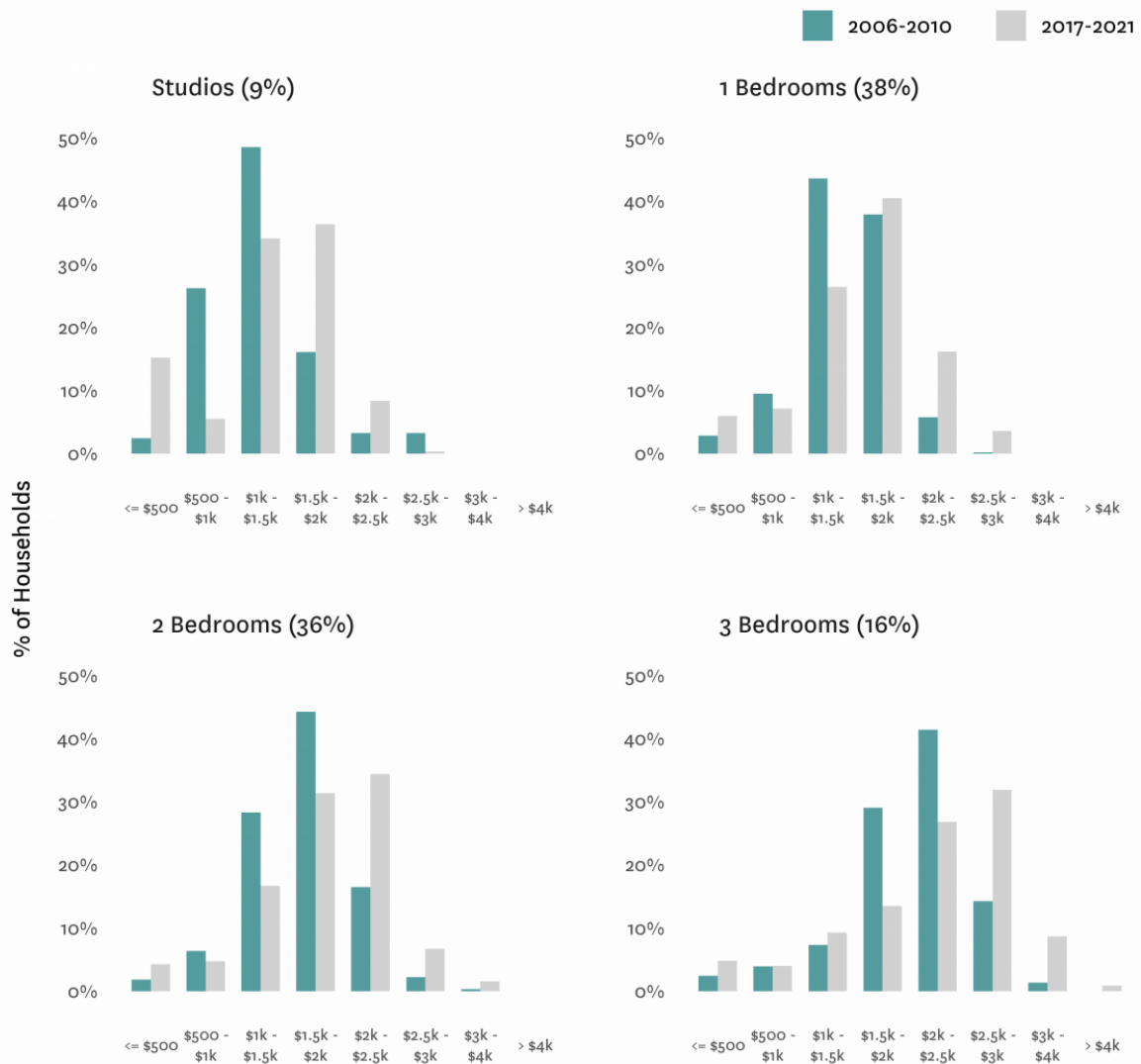
asians.



The serious crime rate was 12.2 serious crimes per 1,000 residents in 2022, compared to 14.2 serious crimes per 1,000 residents citywide.

Although there's a big difference between property crime and violent crime, property crime is the most dominant then violent crime.
