There is no news coverage on this incident, however this is only one of many experiences. All the while two blocks over you'll find many people jogging on the boardwalk at around 5am and you'll be able to experience the tranquility of the breeze and the sight of the waves. Many days there is little to no police presence because of the calming ambience no incidents are ever expected to occur by the shore even during the summer.

In conclusion, although Far Rockaway has amazing shops and boutiques for visitors who decide to spend a day at the beach, residents of Far Rockaway have many stories about the neighborhood, and many feel unsafe. Throughout the years, the 100th precinct has tried to reduce the crime rate of this area by increasing the police presence in heavy crime areas, and this plan has functioned during the busiest times of the year but not through the winter.
