

Racial and Ethnics Compositions






2000's there was a higher percentage of hispanic in Williamsburg but has decreased by 11.9% as of 2021

Socioeconomic Contrast:

Median household income in 2021 was \$107,630, about 49% more than citywide median household income (\$72,150). The poverty rate in Greenpoint/Williamsburg was 18.8% in 2021 compared to 18.0% citywide.



Real median gross rent in Greenpoint/Williamsburg increased from \$1,150 in 2006 to \$2,490 in 2021. This represents a 116.5% increase over the same period.




