Hunts point

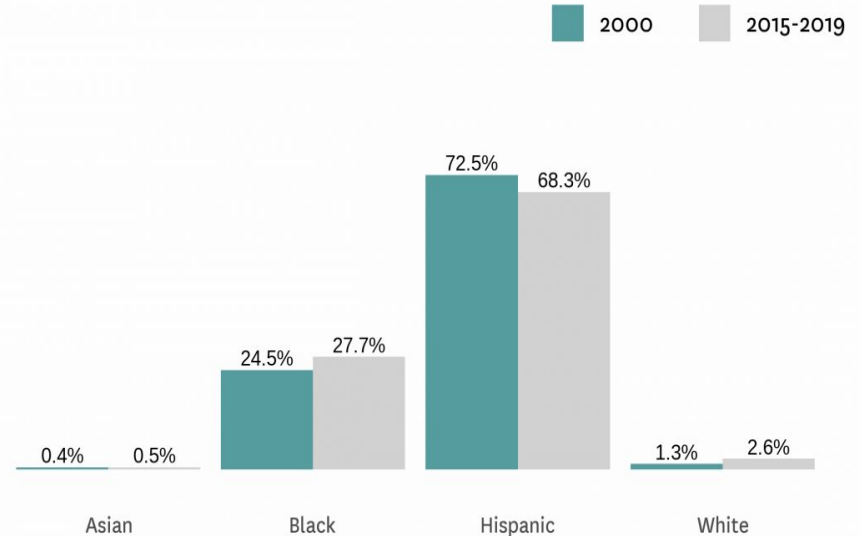

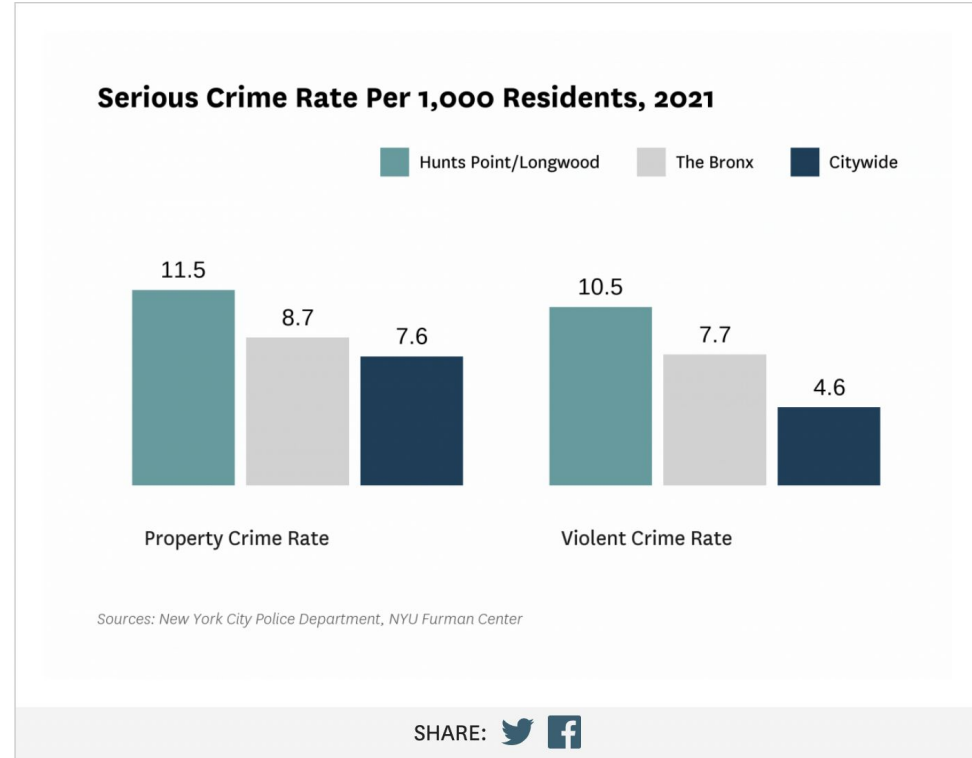
Crime in hunts point
