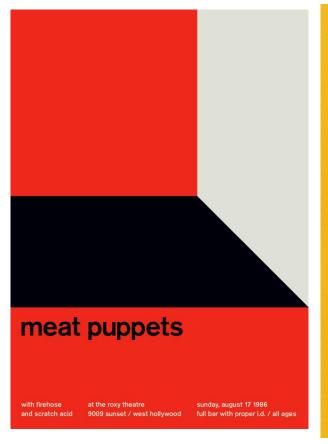
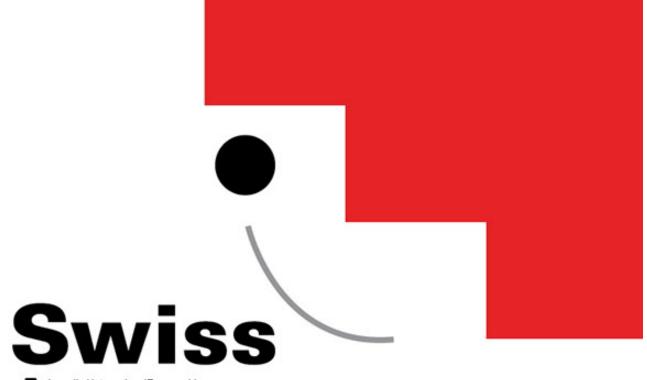
SWISS INTERNATIONAL DESIGN:











Iso called International Typographic Style or International Style. Began in Switzerland in the 1940s and 50s led by Josef Müller-Brockmann and Armin Hofmann. Favored Cleanliness, Readability, and Objectivity.

The grid system is an aid, NOT a guarantee. It permits a number of possible uses

A sans-serif designed by Adrian Frutiger in 1954. Univers is a large family of different weights and widths along with oblique, bold, light, black, extended and condensed. Currently has 44 faces making it a diverse and face typeface to use.
