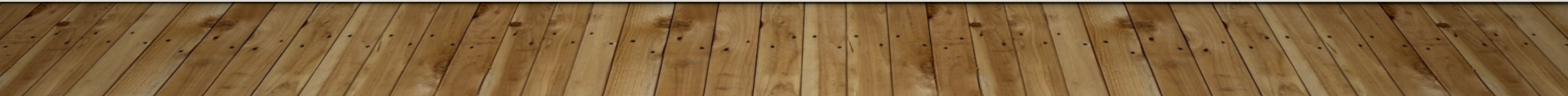

EXPLANATION OF DOMAIN

Describe the following:

- What is the domain?
- What happens in the domain/ What do children do in the domain?
- Why is the domain important in children's development?
- Why did you select the domain? What makes the domain interesting to you?



COMPARE CHILDREN

Compare the children from the Observation Summary Videos:

- Describe the children's functioning in the domain
- What skills and processes did each child demonstrate?
- What factors may have impacted the skills/ processes you observed/ the child's development?
- How was each child's functioning in the domain
 - Similar?
 - Different?



EXPLANATION OF SKILLS & PROCESSES

- Identify 3 skills & processes. Describe how each age group may demonstrate:
 - Infant-toddler
 - Preschool age
 - Young school age
- What should teachers:
 - keep in mind about domain when working with age groups?
 - do to support children's learning in the domain for:
 - Infants-toddlers?
 - Preschool age children?
 - Young school age children?
