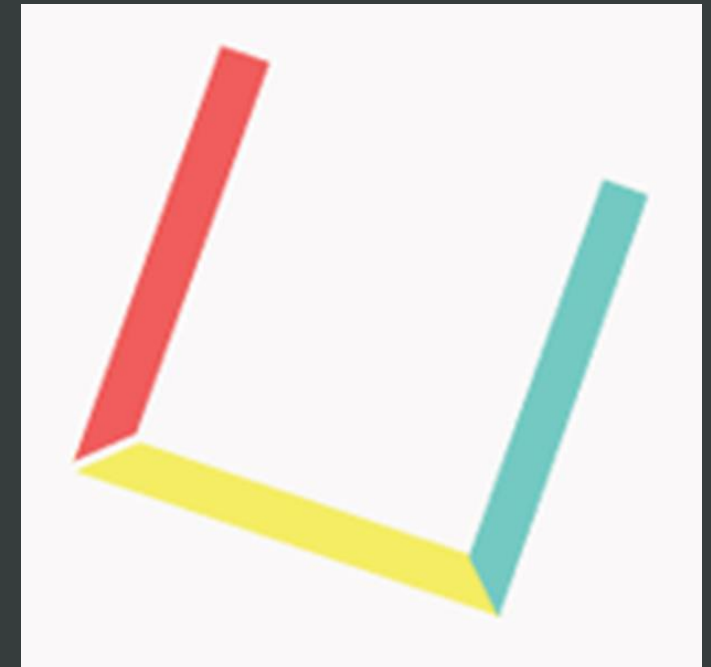
# What is ECE 110-Seminar?
