

Purpose

The Singe Stop Office provides these services through a comprehensive assessment of the needs of the student and offers support with the help of direct and indirect referrals to achieve stability in the student's life.

Grants and Emergency Funds

Carroll & Milton Petrie Grant

BMCC has been a recipient of the Carroll & Milton Petrie Grant since 2014. The Petrie Student Emergency Grant Fund Program seeks to assist eligible students coping with an unexpected hardship, so they may continue their education at BMCC and become financially aware and responsible for their continued education. The programs long-range goal is to ensure the widest range of students' access to its available financial resources with the goal of retention and graduation.

BMCC Foundation Emergency Fund Program

The BMCC Foundation Emergency Fund Program seeks to assist eligible students facing short-term emergencies. The program can assist with transportation, food, small grants and emergency loans.

Lang Foundation Student Emergency Grant

The BMCC Lang Foundation Student Emergency Grant Fund Program seeks to assist the immigrant students with multiple issues, particularly costs associated with legal, educational, and personal needs. The program's long-range goal is to ensure that barriers to the student's education are addressed and that they have access to the widest range of resources with the goal of retention and graduation.

CARES

The Comprehensive Assistance and Retention Empowerment Services Program (CARES) was designed to assist BMCC students who are currently in foster care or have previously been in foster care. This program provides a sense of community among the population by providing students a single point of contact for supportive services.

Housing Information and Resources

The Single Stop office provides information and referral surrounding affordable housing, rental assistance programs, and emergency housing information.

Immigration Assistance

The Single Stop office partners with various agencies to provide students with immigration clinics, forums, and seminars. Students are given the opportunity to meet individually with licensed attorneys to receive valuable information on guidance on their immigration needs.

Pathways to Success

This program is designed to support expectant and parenting teens and young adults to succeed through health and educational services.

Childcare Information & Referrals

The Single Stop office provides information and referrals surrounding subsidized and low-cost child care to students.

BMCC Food Pantry

The Single Stop office works with the Food Bank of New York to provide food assistance to students at BMCC.
