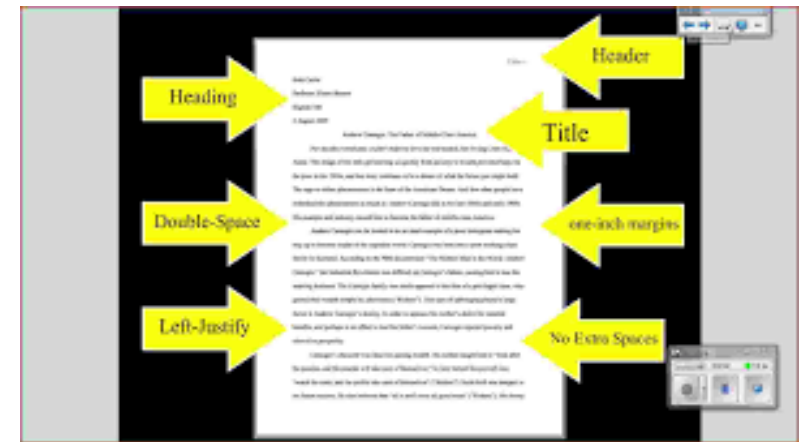

- Connect your definition to your experience of being respected



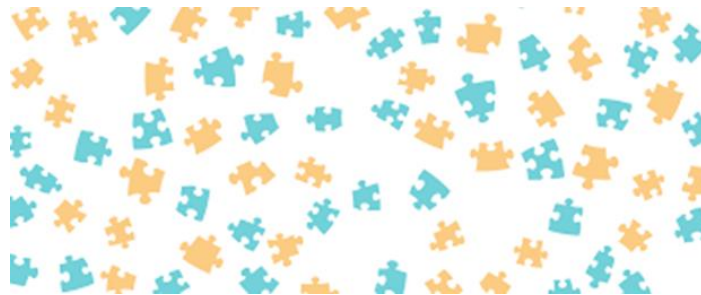
PART III: RESPECTING INFANTS
