<p>Connect your definition of respect to your story of being respected</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • How does your definition of respect relate to your story of being respected? • Make specific connections between your definition & your story

<p>Should infant teachers respect babies in infant classrooms?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Why? • Give specific reasons.
