



Introduction Paragraph

Describe in detail:

- Setting
- Infant's physical appearance
 - OHair (color, texture, length, style)
 - OSkin tone
 - OFacial features
 - OBody type
 - OClothing



Observation Summary

- Start with what happens at beginning
- O 3 vignettes/mini- stories (~2 minutes each in a chronological narrative what happens during your observation, including:
 - What baby does
 - O How baby moves
 - What baby gazes/ looks at
 - What attracts baby's interest & how you know
 - O Toys, materials & furniture baby uses & how
 - O How baby vocalizes (cries, laughs, words

etc.)

- Other ways baby communicates
- Interactions with people including you
- O Anything else you notice
- O Describe at least 1 routine
- End with what happens at end of visit
- Be descriptive & use rich vivid details!

- 3. What did you learn about the family?
- 4. How does the observation connect to ECE 209?
