

Introduction Paragraph

Describe:

- Who was present
- When the observation took place
 - O Day
 - O Date
 - O Time
- Where the observation took place
 - O Borough & neighborhood
 - The space in detail how the furniture was arranged

- OThe materials in the space
- Where you were positioned in the space
- O Infant's physical appearance
 - O Hair -- color, texture, length, style
 - Control Facial features --- eyes, nose, mouth, cheeks, etc.
 - O Body type
 - Clothing



Observation Summary

- Begin with what happens when you arrive
- O Describe 6+ vignettes/ mini- stories that you feel best capture who the baby/ family are:
 - Each vignette ~ 2 minutes of observation
 - Explain how the child:
 - O ACTED
 - O INTERACTED
 - O REACTED
 - Include at least 1 routine
- End with what happens when you leave
- Be descriptive -- use rich vivid details so the reader can picture what's happening!



Conclusion Paragraph:



- 1. What struck you from the observation?
 - ODuring the observation
 - OWriting the paper
- 2. What did you learn about the child?
- 3. What did you learn about the family?
- 4. How does the observation connect to ECE 209?

- OBe objective write what you see
- OInclude important:
 - OFacts
 - ODetails
 - OPatterns of behavior
