## ECE 209-L REVISED Commentary Paper Guidelines

6+ pages, type written, double-spaced, 12 pt font, 1" margins, APA format for citations

In this paper you will have the opportunity to analyze all of that information you have gathered about your child and family to give a coherent and thoughtful picture of the child in the context of their family. You will apply what you have learned in ECE 209 to the child and family. Over the course of this semester, you have gathered information about the child and family in the following ways:

- 1. By interviewing/ talking to family members.
- 2. By observing the child and family.

You will compare what you have observed, done, and heard to what you've read in the assigned course readings, and what you've learned in the class. Your Reading Response Papers, materials from class, and your class notes should help. You will need to reread everything you have written both formally and informally.

## To develop your paper:

- While writing the paper, focus on describing and analyzing the following aspects areas:
  - The child's prenatal history, birth, and early days
  - Developmental domains
  - Play & learning
  - The family & cultural practices
- Reread your interview and observation. Decide what you want to include from each paper.
   Make sure it connects with whatever else you are writing.
- Look through the notes and handouts from class. Decide what relates your family and child.
- Review your Reading Response Papers. Flag the pages from the assigned course readings
  that apply to child and family. Think of how the information connects either in support of or
  contrast to what you have observed, heard, learned or written in your papers thus far. Identify
  where in your paper you will want to include ideas or quotations from sources.
  - o Cite the sources whenever referring to them.
    - When using an idea from a source, put the authors' names and the date of publication (Darling-Kuria & Bohlander, 2014) in parentheses next to the statement.
    - When quoting a source:
      - use quotation marks to show words are copied directly from a source
      - include the page number where the quote can be found (Honig, 2007, p. 7) in the citation.
  - List all of the references at the end of your paper.
  - All assigned readings are listed in APA format on Open Lab, under the "Resources" menu item. Copy the citation in APA format from the list.
- Proofread your paper, checking:
  - Are observations and interpretations non-judgmental (objective) and respectful of the child and family?
  - o Does the organization of the paper make sense?
  - o Is it written in a way that enables the reader to picture the child and family?
  - Have I seamlessly integrated materials from class and sources into the paper?
  - Does the paper refer too class materials and three assigned course readings?
- Number the pages of your paper.
