for instance, this is all the wheat a society produced



all that wheat is then used to sustain the people (labor) and plant wheat for the next season (materials)




if the total product is enough to cover the labor and materials needed to make it, then they society will be able to make the same amount of wheat (Total Product) in the next season

Total Product Total Produ season 2



if the Total Product isn't enough to sustain labor or materials, then Total Production in season 2 will be less than before





what happens if we are able to produce more than the necessary product?

surplus **Necessary Product** surplus product is the part labor **labor** of the total product over and above the necessary product OR materials materials the surplus is the part of production left over after **Total Product Total Product** paying labor and material season 2 costs

what can we do with the surplus product?

- "unproductive" things
- more leisure
- higher wages
- more workers
- more/better materials
- new technology
- market capture


