

To find secondary source articles in BMCC library databases:

On the BMCC home page, click "LIBRARY" at the very top of the page on the right (next to "Donate to BMCC").

On the Library page, click "Databases A-Z by Subject."

On new page, click "Complete List of Databases" under "Databases A-Z by Subject."

Choose a database that is relevant to your topic. For this assignment, you might click Academic Search Premier, Academic Search Complete, or JSTOR, for example.

Enter a search term. For this assignment, you might start by clicking "Fairy Tales."

A drop-down menu will give you some ideas for how to narrow down your topic.

If you know your narrowed down topic, type it in the search box; e.g. "Fairy Tales AND Childhood Development"

If you are writing about a specific fairy tale, you might type in the title of the story.

When the search results show up, browse through the titles. Find an article that seems relevant to your topic. Make sure a PDF version of the article is available and download it.

You can also just try using One Search on the Library Home page.
