

The first video talks about one of the most worst tragedy that has happen in the united states and it was "The triangle shirtwaist factory fire, most the employee were women and teenager that didn't speak english, the fire started on a regular working day they tried to stop the fire but they couldn't due to the fact that the factory didn't have any sprinklers which may the fire spread faster. All the employee started to panic because the factory only had one fire escape and it wasn't big enough for everyone and it ended up collapsing, the building had 4 elevator but one was working at the time of the fire and it only managed to do four trips before collapsing. People so desperate to get out they started jumping to death and other people were trying to use the stairs to get out to find out the worse and it was that the they couldn't open the doors because they used to keep them locked. 146 people died in the factory fire and the owners of the factory were accused of manslaughter but were found not guilty by the court. This was such a tragedy because the factory was not a safe place to work and it didn't offer its employee a safe work place and that why so many innocent people die. After this tragedy people were demanding changes and the need to redefine the american industrial workers and making laws to prevent a tragedy like the shirtwaist factory fire making mandatory for factories to have a sprinkler system and other measures that would make the workplace more safe. The second video "triangle return" basically talk about the aftermath of the tragedy of the triangle shirtwaist factory fire. He talking about how many women were jumping out the window because they wanted to give something to their family to be buried.

After the tragedy thousands of workers went on the street to protest and demand for better working conditions. Things like fire exit that can not be locked. In 2018 the same story happened in a factory in Bangladesh when the factory caught fire and when the employee tried to get out the same thing happened the doors were all locked and the only option they had was to jump out the window. They work 12 to 14 hours a day seven days a week just to get one day off a month and they still living in misery because what they are getting paid is so little. Bangladesh factories are responsible for the exportation of big companies like Gap and Walmart and these workers are not getting paid 28 cents an hour, they were protesting to see if they can get a rise on their wages but instead the police were attacking the workers. It is really sad that big companies act like they can't pay them 35 cents when they make so much money out of their work and instead of giving them what they are asking for they are being attacked and beaten. This video talks about how everything is going backwards in the global economy and is not supposed to be like that 100 years later after the Triangle Shirtwaist Factory fire things like this are still happening. The article talks about equal rights amendment and how for women is something that would give women more opportunity and being taken into consideration. Paul was part of the women suffrage movement she was sentenced to prison for protesting in front of the White House and they forced her to eat after a prison hunger strike after all this she still believes the women deserve more than just the right to vote and she believes they were entitled to have all the rights, but not all women agree with the fact that women should be working and

being in some way treated like men. Phylis Schlafly believed that women should stay home with the children just how it used to be before, she believed "equal right amendment would take away the right of women to be supported by their husband" (Phyllis, page 4) this shows how she was totally okay with being a stay home mother and that would damage their traditions and it seems like she didn't want any type of evolution for women and as a woman as well.
