



## Internal Audit Mentorship Program with BMCC

Our Internal Audit division in partnership with BMCC, are pleased to share the Internal Audit Mentorship Program – a six-week program designed to support and develop students of diverse backgrounds with an interest in exploring financial services.

By the end of the program, participants will be equipped with an understanding of the financial services industry, our role as Internal Auditors in a global institution, and have the tools and guidance to navigate career opportunities.

### How to Get Started?

Identify students who would benefit from this learning experience.

Students should:

- Be in their second year at BMCC with a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0
- Be pursuing a Bachelor's degree in Fall 2022
- Have an interest in financial services
- Commit to participating in the entire six-week program

### How Will it Work?

Throughout the six-week program, students will be:

- Paired with a mentor dedicated to helping students better understand the course concepts to foster their learning and growth
- Partaking in bi-weekly information sessions covering financial services and Internal Audit
- Guided with relevant skills to aid in their successful transition to a four-year institution.

- **Morgan Stanley 101:** Introducing students to Morgan Stanley, including key lines of business, the firm's role as a market maker and the role of Internal Audit in the firm's overall governance structure.
- **Internal Audit 101:** Bridging the gap between Morgan Stanley as a business and Internal Audit as an independent function through the exploration of core audit processes and terminology (e.g., risks, controls), interactive examples of a day in the life of an auditor with comparisons between external and internal auditing.
- **Career Development Panel Discussion:** Hearing from current employees on their tips for interviewing and resume-building, the importance of networking and their career journeys at Morgan Stanley.
