Who is "John Wick"?

ohn Wick is an American action thriller media franchise created by Derek Kolstad and owned by Summit Entertainment. Keanu Reeves plays John Wick, a retired hitman seeking vengeance for the killing of the dog given to him by his recently-deceased wife.

The franchise began with the release of John Wick in 2014 followed by two sequels, John Wick: Chapter 2 on February 10, 2017, and John Wick: Chapter 3 – Parabellum on May 17, 2019. All three films were considered critical and commercial successes, accumulating a collective gross of more than \$587 million worldwide. A fourth installment, John Wick: Chapter 4, is in production and is due to be released on May 21, 2021.





Ahead of its sequel, let's review how John Wick became an instant action classic.
