- She demonstrated good hand-eye coordination as she was able to guide where she wanted every detail to go on her portrait.

- Praptee had mastered the ability to speak clearly. Her teacher understood the answers she was giving her.
- She was able to have natural conversations with her teacher.





# COGNITIVE DEVELOPMENT

- Praptee demonstrated she could create simple sentences and knew which punctuation to use at the end of it.
- Praptee used different shapes to put together her portrait.
- When she was drawing in her portrait, she would look down at the clothing she was wearing to replicate that onto the portrait.





## REFLECTION / COMMENTARY

- The teacher did a great job by giving Praptee an activity that kept her engaged.
- The interview section was interesting because it allowed us to see why she made the choices she did in her portrait.
- Using activities that allow children the opportunity to be creative is a helpful strategy because it can help teachers see how children express themselves. It gives them an idea of their interests which can be helpful when its time to create the curriculum.
