- 1. Play: Create a play about flowers
- 2. Painting: painting with flower

- 1. Museum- cataloged the different plants
- 2. Painting- paint a earth
- **3.** Arts and Crafts- Build a water cycle chamber



How to care for plants

Book: The tiny seed by Eric Carle

- **1. Song:** Create a class song that will be sung to the plants using planting tools
- 2. grass house- Build a house out of sponges and grow a plant
- **3. Walking trip:** recommend a walking trip to find plants growing in unusual places, to bring their awareness to how plants can grow in many kinds of ways

- 1. Beehive- Build a paper mache beehive
- 2. Bee- Build a paper mache bee
- 3. Food- Make honey
