

# **Dramatic Play**

- 1. Classic Maple Leaf Kitchen Island, which can support children's drama.
- 2. Kitchen Units, these kitchen units allow children to pretend to cook.

#### **Reflective Response**

According to the picture and lists of my classroom environment, I will use various learning centers and materials to support children's creative expression and the arts. For example, during circle time, I could tell a story for children and share ideas with each other. The circle time can support children to participate in collective discussion, and be inspired by each other. Thus, we can talk about their creative activities and projects for the works of small groups. Next, children can use many materials to try their creative ideas. These materials that I have prepared for each learning center, such as the Art Center. Through small group activities that make children have opportunities to try their new ideas, making mistakes, gaining insights from each other, and finally generating innovative methods to make artworks. Therefore, these learning environments can support the creative expression and the arts of children.

In addition, the different materials also provide children with different learning opportunities. I will set up books with various cultural, religious and ethnic backgrounds, and write different language labels for each learning material. Moreover, I would ask children to show their structures with photos of their families, all of which add richness to the scene. For example, in my environment, there is a family tree that respects children and their families culture. In my classroom environment, the learning centers support children's development across various domains. For example, science center, math center, libraries and music center develop children's cognitive ability. Children could learn new things during their playtime by the materials in these centers. Moreover, the writing center, art center, and libraries develop children's language/literacy abilities, and these centers also support children's small motor skills. Because children practice how to hold a pen, write and draw in these learning centers. In addition, the circle time, block center and dramatic play can support children's socialization/emotion. Children could talk to each other about their creative activities or projects and share their feelings in these centers.

In my classroom environment, I set many plant and culture materials. These items show developmentally and culturally appropriate practice. For example, there are many plants in the science center and libraries, which can make the space more attractive, and provide children with the opportunity to develop observation skills and use these insights in work. In addition, I prepared many books and pictures about different cultures and races, which reflected different races, traditions and families. These could support children's self-identity to the community of the classroom.
