Increase in out of state abortions

Patients from Texas are seeking abortions in other states due to the law.

Washington: A law was passed in the state of Washington that banned women from having abortions and due to the ban, patients are now seeking abortions elsewhere. This ban follows the recent Texan abortion law. The Texan ban was enacted May 19th, 2021, and commenced September 1st, 2021, and states a woman can not have an abortion once a fetal heartbeat is detected. In Washington, this law will start in June, and ahead of the commencement, these procedures are being done in other states.
