ASPCA Free Adoption Weeks!

Aspca is waving adoption fees for the next 2 weeks!!!. Starting from the 11 to 31st of December, in hopes of influencing more people to adopt a pet from a shelter. Animals would make a great Christmas present for your kids. We are hoping for an increase of adoptions this season to make more space for other homeless cats and dogs so that we can save even more lives.

This promotion is available throughout all of our Nyc locations, and free neuter+ vaccinations for your new pet. We are also providing your new pet with a chip, so that if they ever get lost you can locate them fast. We hope you consider adopting from a shelter, as you would be giving these pets a new warm place they can call home.

Founded in 1866 by Henry Bergh, we believe that cruelty to animals is wrong and should never be allowed to happen, as when Henry observed someone ready to beat his fallen horse, Henry had stopped him and realized at that moment that he wanted to save animal lives. This started off more as a horse cruelty prevention but slowly started to expand to other animals and services, such as a horse ambulance that first operated in 1867. ASPCA was the first humane society in the western hemisphere, which lead to New York passing the first anti-cruelty law. ASPCA has also donated to other shelters, as well as works with the NYPD to try and take down any sign of animal cruelty.

ASPCA continues to show the importance of neutering and adopting from a shelter, in 2017 we had an increase of 18.5% in adoptions and saw a dramatic decrease of the intake of homeless dogs or cats and those that had to be euthanized. We hope to keep seeing these numbers improve as every pet deserves a good chance at life.
