Dramatic Play/ Puppets:

- Role-play props like firefighter hats, police badges, and chef hats
- Pretend cameras for imaginative play
- Play money with different denominations for realistic transactions
- Storybooks related to different careers for inspiration
- Pretend stovetop with knobs that turn
- Plastic pots and pans in various sizes
- Plastic cooking utensils such as spatulas, ladles, and spoons
- Pretend oven with a door that opens
- Play food items like plastic fruits, vegetables, and meats
- Plastic dishes, cups, and utensils for serving
- Sink with a faucet for pretend washing
- Play kitchen appliances such as a microwave, blender, and toaster
- Aprons and chef hats for role-playing
- Menu boards or order pads for taking pretend orders

Visual Arts (2-D and 3-D):

- Texture plates for creating sensory art
- Glitter glue for adding sparkle to projects
- Chalkboard or dry-erase easels for drawing and writing activities
- Natural materials like leaves, sticks, and feathers for mixed-media art

Block Center:

- Miniature animals and people figurines for storytelling
- Plastic mirrors for exploring symmetry and reflection
- Ramps and inclines for experimenting with physics and motion
- Labels with pictures and words to organize block sets

Math Manipulatives/Puzzles:

- Fraction tiles for hands-on understanding of fractions
- Clock puzzles for learning about time intervals
- Balance scales for exploring weight and measurement concepts
- Dice and number spinners for math games and activities

Writing/Literacy:

- Storytelling props like puppets and story stones
- Magnetic letters and boards for word-building activities
- Laminated alphabet and number mats for tracing with dry-erase markers
- Alphabet and phonics games for interactive learning

Library/Quiet Space:

- Cozy reading nooks with cushions, blankets, and soft lighting
- Listening stations with headphones for audio books and stories

- Story sequencing cards for retelling and comprehension activities
- Book bins labeled with genres or themes for easy book selection

Small Building (Table-Top):

- Magnifying glasses for observing details in small objects
- Tinker toys or building connectors for open-ended construction
- LEGO or DUPLO sets for structured building challenges
- Suction cup building pieces for vertical construction on windows or walls

Music/Movement/Dance:

- Ribbon wands for rhythmic movement and dance

- Musical storybooks with accompanying CDs for multisensory experiences -instruments
