


Instructions: Using black and white triangles of any size and style, create a composition for each type of emphasis: size, shape, placement, isolation, value, direction.


Study the negative space created "behind" the arrows as well as the "foreground" shapes. Pay attention to the relationship of the triangles with the bounding box and the cropping.


