<b><a href="#">Content: Quality and Attribution</a></b>	15	Each page has: (1) Site Header, (2) Navigation, (3) Site Footer, (4) Page content. The first three should be the same on every page. If you include images, then give credit to the creator (even if it's you). Page Content should include all <a href="#">content given for each page</a>

NAME	%	DESCRIPTION
<b><a href="#">Visual Design: Layout</a></b>	10	The page layout that you have used presents the content in a way that makes it clear where one section of content ends and the next begins and puts content in an order that makes it easy for the user to view content.
<b><a href="#">Visual Design: Typography</a></b>	10	Text is readable, scannable and typographic elements (color, size, font etc) are used to create a hierarchy of content. The typographic hierarchy should be consistent across content of the same type and across pages.
<b><a href="#">Interaction Design</a></b>	10	Navigation is present, clickable items (links, buttons) are clearly clickable, and it's clear what will happen if an item is clicked.
