




Child Poverty in New York State




Jobs and education


SEED Program findings

• "The control group experienced nearly 1.5x more income volatility than the treatment group" (16).

• "The treatment group experienced clinically and statistically significant improvements in their mental health that the control group did not" (17).

Finnish Guaranteed Income Experiment



- "Environmental stress is especially damaging in the first three years of a child's life. <u>Studies suggest</u> strong links between childhood poverty and cognitive and psychological disadvantages, including physical differences in the shape and function of brains."
- "Reducing stress in early childhood is critical, and helping moms meet their needs is a first step to setting these babies up for success."
