

## BMCC OER/ZTC Definitions

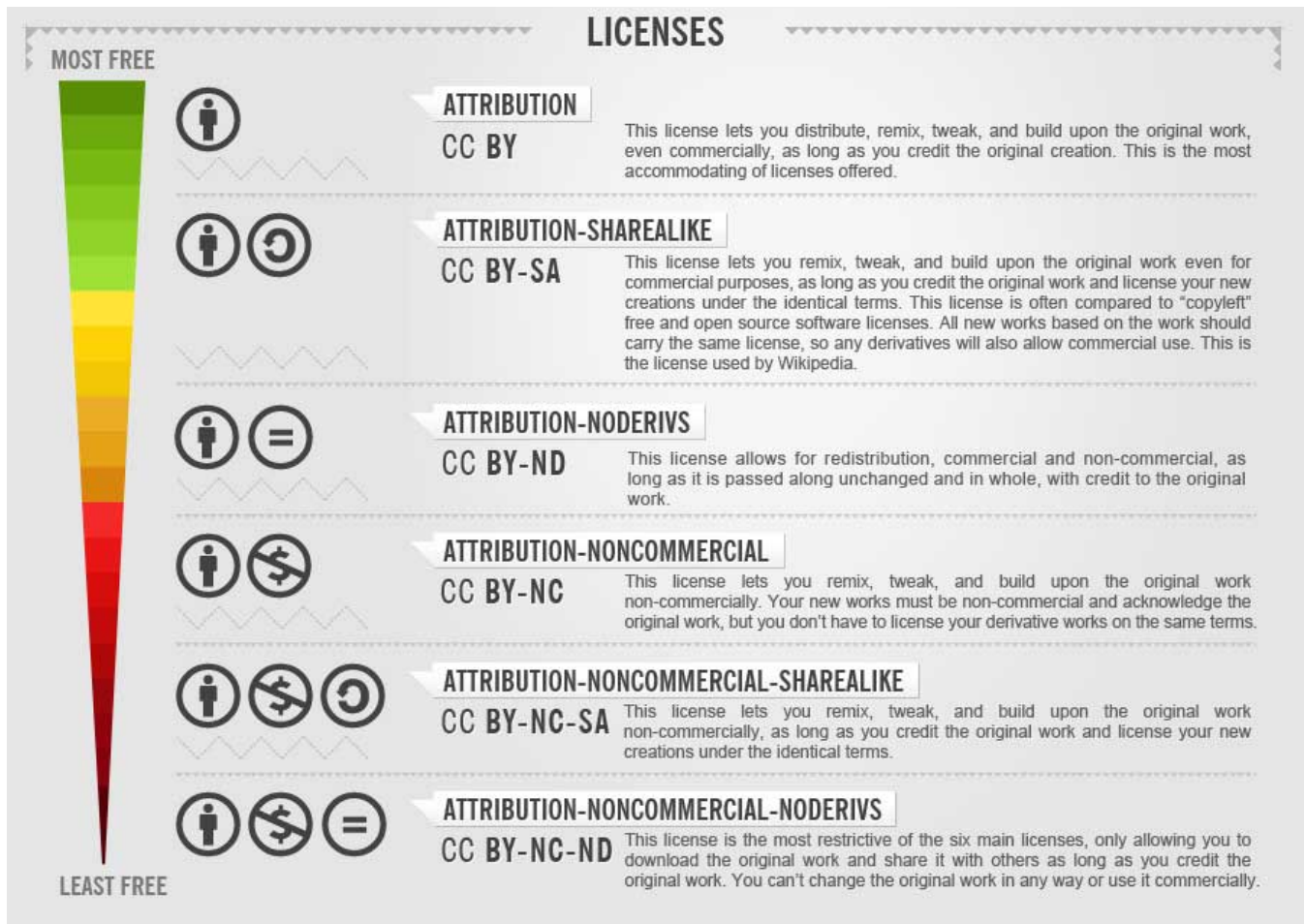
### What is ZTC (zero textbook cost or no additional cost to students)?

- Material you create
- Material owned or licensed by the Library (links are preferable)
- Material that can be linked to on the Web
- Material that is covered by fair use
- Material in the public domain
- Material copyright holder has given permission for use in writing (including CC-licensed OER)

### What are OER?

- Educational materials with a Creative Commons license

**CC licenses give permission for use up front.** No need to ask for permission or to do a fair use analysis.

There is also **CC 0** which is no rights reserved (the equivalent of being in the public domain).
