CALL FOR PAPERS

New York's multicultural richness would be unthinkable without the various contributions made by the different groups of immigrants from all over the world who have settled in the city. For the V Student Symposium of Modern Languages, *Multicultural Legacies in New York*, we invite students to make a presentation on one of these contributions in the diverse fields of music, performing arts, visual arts, architecture, gastronomy, language and literature, celebrations or festivals. Students can do their presentations on a broad topic (Mexican food, for example), or focus on a particular artist or prominent person in New York. They can also focus on a specific socio-cultural institution or traditions of a particular group that has become ingrained in the diverse New York community. Any related topic that is of interest to you and not been mentioned in the list will also be accepted.

Individual sessions and panels:

Students can make an individual proposal or coordinate a panel on a specific topic. Presentations can be made in English or any of the languages taught in the Modern Languages Department and each presenter will have 15 minutes for his/her/their presentation. They can accompany their presentations with photographs or videos. They can even interview a prominent person in the city, make a recording and present a short 8-minute video.

Proposals and registration

Students will submit a 100-150-word abstract of their presentations before April 5th, 2024. Proposals, along with the Registration Form, may be sent to one of the coordinators of the Symposium.
