The Modern Language Department announces its 4th Micro Story Contest for BMCC students. Participants must conform to the following guidelines:

- 1. Any student enrolled at BMCC during the Spring 2024 semester is eligible to participate.
- 2. There will be a different category for each of the languages taught in the Modern Languages Department: Spanish, French, Italian, Chinese, Arabic, Portuguese and American Sign Language. There is also a category for Spanglish.
- 3. Micro stories must not exceed 150 words.
- 4. The topic of the micro story is open.
- 5. Participants can submit a maximum of two unpublished, non-previously awarded micro stories. They can also participate in more than one category.
- 6. Winners of the 3rd contest are not eligible to participate.
- 7. All pieces should be submitted online as an attachment to mldmicrofiction@gmail.com the subject line should include the participating category, i.e., Arabic, Chinese, French, Italian, Spanish, Spanglish, Portuguese or American Sign Language.
- 8. The body of the message must include the following author information: first and last name, student ID number, major, e-mail and phone number.
- 9. The deadline to submit the short stories is April 5, 2024.
- 10. There will be a first and second prize for each category.
- 11. Awards will be announced on April 17, 2024.
