II. Body: As you all know there was so much more to Clifton than just his lust for the human experience.

- a. Cliff was a wonderful friend
- b. He cared about others.
- c. One thing I will never forget about Cliff is that he lived his way.
- d. He had NO filter.

III. Conclusion: Cliff had no regrets, and would have really enjoyed this gathering, but would be wondering why we were wasting so much time talking about his life rather than living our own.
