LANDSCAPE



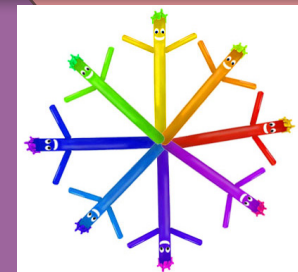

POSTER



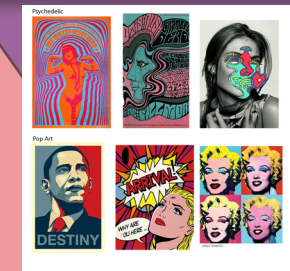
