REVISED SYLLABUS COURSE CONTENT FOR SOC 100 Sections 1708 and 1902

ZOOM CLASS NEXT WEEK ON TUESDAY APRIL 28 @ 530PM

We will continue class online next week and we will discuss **WEEK 6 ONLINE: EDUCATION** - the state of higher education in the US...also watch some of the videos on education in THE US and the video on Education around the world and **REFLECTION 5 on RACE AND ETHNICITY** - come prepared with your discussion on race, racism, prejudice, discrimination and stereotypes as they pertain to or affect various segments of racial and ethnic minorities.

The reflection paper 5 (**REFLECTION 5 on RACE AND ETHNICITY** - on race, racism, prejudice, discrimination and stereotypes as they pertain to or affect various segments of racial and ethnic minorities) will be used as your final class paper so take your time to work on it. It will be due on the last day of class. Next week, we will only discuss and share responses to the discussion questions. After you write your paper, you will present it in class for the final exam. I will group together students who wrote similar topics to lead discussions and present their PPT presentation.

LAST ZOOM CLASS / LAST WEEKLY DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

Tuesday April 28th will be our LAST zoom class and weekly discussion questions. I will skip week 7 online and week 8 online work so that you can catch up on previously due work and participation and also prepare for the final exams presentation and paper. You are responsible for reviewing the work for the 2 weeks (See week 7 online and week 8 online folder on OL) so that you can complete the last survey on Social Inequality (see week 7 online folder for the link).

We will reconvene in 2 weeks time (5/14 at 530PM – 830PM) via zoom to hear the presentations or discussion on the FINAL EXAM (see below):

After the last day of class or during the reading week, you will then work on the written paper for the final exam (of course do not wait until the last minute to work on your paper - START the draft now:)

The 2 weeks off should also be used in catching up on WEEK 1, 2,3,4,5 AND 6 ONLINE QUESTIONS, PARTICIPATION RESPONSE TO OTHER STUDENTS AND REFLECTIONS 2,3,4 AND 4. AFTER THE LAST DAY OF CLASS ON MAY 14 I WILL NOT ACCEPT ANY PREVIOUSLY DUE WORK FOR THE CLASS BESIDES YOUR FINAL PAPER.

FINAL EXAM

1) RESEARCH on the ONE ISSUE you have selected: 1) RACIAL DISCRIMINATION, 2) CRIME AND PUNISHMENT, 3) DEVIANCE AND SOCIAL CONTROL – DUE THURSDAY MAY 22ND (Reflection 5 folder for guiding questions, sample papers, videos, select suggested reading. You are to conduct additional research and also follow the citation guidelines).

- 2) PRESENT (a PPT) on how THIS ONE ISSUE affects the society and the ways in which it impacts society's day to day functions. Provide some specific research and cited examples on how this ONE issue affects specific groups or segments of racial and ethnic minorities (See week 5 reflection page for sample questions to consider responses to when working on both your presentation and paper) DUE THURSDAY MAY 14TH.
- 3) <u>DISCUSS</u> how ONE of the SOCIOLOGICAL PERSPECTIVES views the ways in which that issue in section 1 affects the society: FUNCTIONALIST THEORY, SYMBOLIC THEORY, FUNCTIONALIST THEORY. After I will group students working on the same topic from part one together to lead the discussion and share their presentations with us <u>DUE THURSDAY MAY 14TH</u>.
- 4) WRITE A 5 PAGE PAPER (5 8 pages) on 1, 2, and 3 above. You will then provide recommendations from a Sociological Perspective by incorporating and reading or discussion that we have had throughout the course of the semester. Feel free to interview others such as friends, family and colleagues on the impact of the ONE ISSUE that you have selected and share some of their personal (and or yours in your final paper) Due last day of the FINAL EXAM FRIDAY MAY 22ND BY 11:30PM.
