

III Micro Story Contest

The Modern Language Department announces its 3rd Micro Story Contest for BMCC students. Participants must conform to the following guidelines:

- 1. Any student enrolled at BMCC during the 2021-2022 academic year is eligible to participate.
- 2. Micro stories must not exceed 150 words.
- 3. The topic of the micro story is open.
- 4. Participants can submit a maximum of two unpublished, non-previously awarded micro stories.
- 5. Winners of the 2nd Contest are not eligible to participate.
- 6. There will be a different category for each of the languages taught in the Modern Languages Department: Spanish, French, Italian, Chinese, Arabic and American Sign Language. There will be a new category for **Spanglish**.
- 7. All pieces should be submitted online as an attachment to mldmicrofiction@gmail.com the subject line should include the participating category, i.e., Arabic, Chinese, French, Italian, Spanish, Spanglish or American Sign Language.
- 8. The body of the message must include the following author information: first and last name, student ID number, major, e-mail and phone number.
- 9. The deadline to submit the short stories is April 22nd 2022.
- 10. There will be a first and second prize for each category.
- 11. Awards will be presented on May 6th 2022 in a virtual ceremony. Awardees will read their pieces.
