- ¹ Developmental courses have 0 credits, however, their hours are counted towards full-time status and for financial aid purposes.
- ² ECE 110 is a prerequisite course to all others ECE courses. Students are strongly encouraged to take ECE 110 in their first year.
- ³ MAT 214.5 is a combination of MAT 56 and MAT 214. Students must either take this combination course or if the MAT 56 exemption test is passed, then students are advised to take MAT 214.
- ⁴ ECE 110 must be passed with a grade of "C" or better in order to take ECE 210 and ECE 211.
- ⁵ Students are required to complete two semesters of the same Modern Foreign Language in order to graduate, one of which can be satisfied in the World Cultures and Global Issues requirement.
- ⁶ ECE 210 and ECE 211 must be passed with a grade of "C" or better in order to take ECE 311 and ECE 312.
- ⁷ ECE 311 and ECE 312 must be passed with a grade of "C" or better in order to take ECE 410 and ECE 411.
- ⁸ PHY 110 is an alternative option.
- ⁹ ART 104 is an alternative option.
- ¹⁰ SPE 102 is an option for non-native speakers of English.
