Musicians



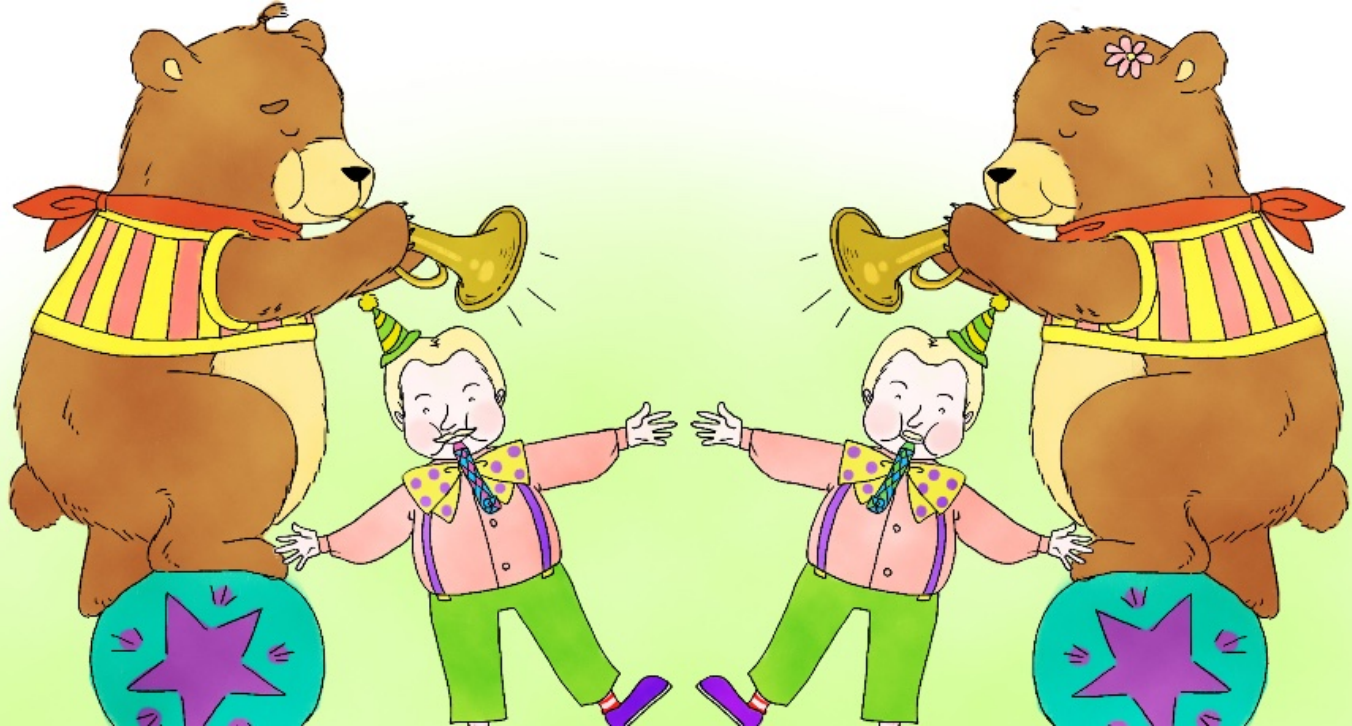
In a circus, they have lots of music. So there are a lot of musicians. They come from all over the world.

There are people that work with the animals.

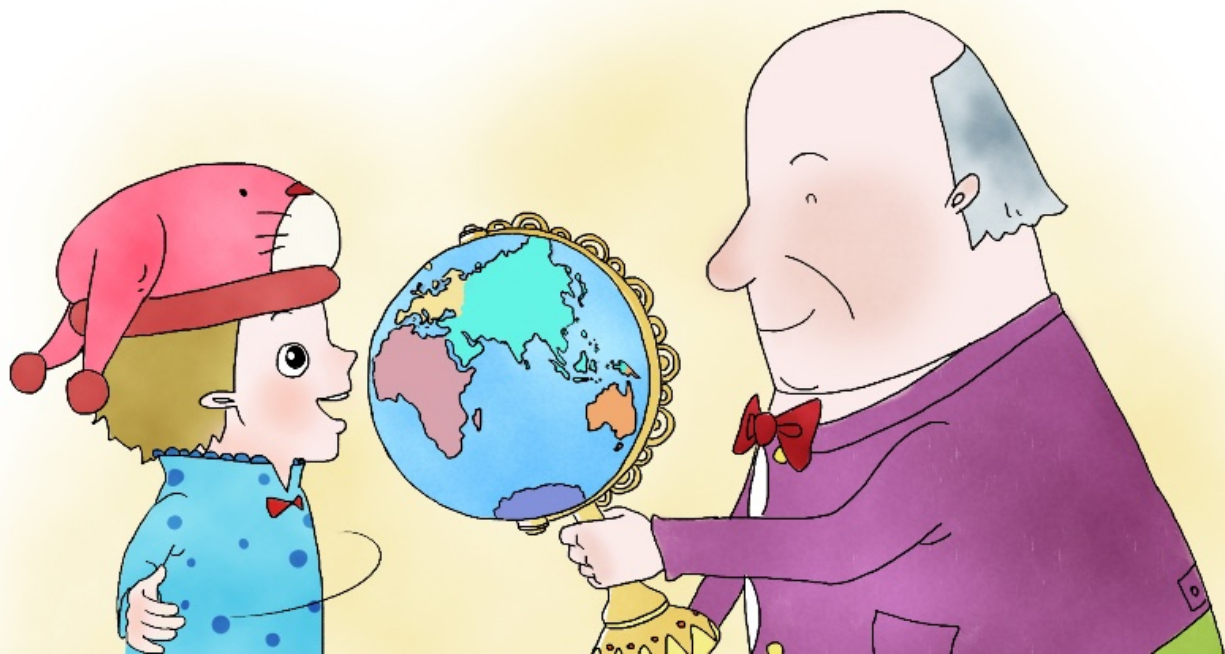




They can teach them how to do different tricks, like stand on balls and play instruments.
